

INFORMATION NOTE ON DATA PROTECTION

ATFM Exemptions

The purpose of this information note is to inform data subjects on the processing of their personal data by the Directorate of Civil Aviation ("DAC") in the context of the issuance of ATFM Exemptions.

Purpose and legal basis for the processing

Personal data are processed for the purpose of aviation safety in the context of air traffic flow management.

The legal basis for this processing is Commission Regulation (EU) No 255/2010 of 25 March 2010 laying down common rules on air traffic flow management.

Recipients (or categories of recipients) of the personal data

Personal data are accessible and processed by the DAC EA & A/D & ATM/ANS Department (airspace, aerodromes, air traffic management and national supervisory authority).

Personal data are also accessible by the Administration de la Navigation aérienne.

<u>Transfer to a third country or international organisation</u>

No personal data is transferred to a third country or an international organisation.

Period for which personal data will be stored

Personal data are stored for a maximum period of 10 years after issuance of the exemption.

Right to request access to and rectification or erasure or restriction of processing and to object to processing

The data subject has the right to request from the controller access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning the data subject or to object to processing.

Data protection officer ("DPO")

If the data subject wants to assert the rights to request access to and rectification or erasure or restriction of processing and to object to processing, or suspects a violation of personal data, they may contact the DAC's DPO:

- via regular post to the aforementioned address.

Proof of identity has to be included in the request (ex. copy of identity card or passport, licence number, etc.).

Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the national supervisory authority CNPD ("Commission nationale pour la protection des données", https://cnpd.public.lu/en.html).

Nature of requirement to provide personal data and possible consequences of failure to provide these data

The provision of personal data is a statutory requirement. The data subject is obliged to provide these data in order to obtain the issuance of ATFM Exemptions. Failure to provide these data will prevent the issuance of the exemption.

Existence of automated decision-making

Personal data processed by the DAC are not subject to automated decision-making.
